### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### Course Description:

In *Primary Programmers Essentials* students will learn basic programming concepts using a standard programming language, such as *Java*. From variables and data types to loops and arrays, students will learn basic algorithm development and create small software projects. Recommended for first timers. Students will have to take three *Primary Programming Essentials* (Fall, Winter & Spring) courses to be qualified for *Primary Programmers Advanced*. In *Primary Programmers Advanced* students will learn graphical user interface development using an integrated development environment, such as *NetBeans*. Students will develop basic skills in object oriented programming building advanced software projects. Recommended for students who have attended either *Primary Programming I* or *II* in 2012-13 school year. Students can take this course as many time they want.
